In continuation with the presentation given to the students last month regarding the International Award for Youth Programme, we would like to reiterate the following.

This award was formerly known as the Duke of Edinburgh award. The aim of this award is to motivate young people of the age 14 to 25 years to become involved in a voluntary self -development program.

The basic structure of the Award consists of 4 mandatory sections Service, Adventurous Journey, Skills and Physical Recreation.

There are 3 levels of the Award – Bronze, Silver & Gold. Participants must complete the four mandatory sections of Service, Adventurous Journey, Skill & Physical Recreation.

Participants can undertake all three categories of the Award programme or enter directly at any of the three levels in the following age group; Bronze Award (for those over 14), Silver Award (for those over 15) and Gold Award (for those over 16 years).
